Entry Requirements

Applicants who are interested and seeking admission to technical training program should:

- ① Medically fit .
- ② Have General Education Certificate or its equivalent .
- ③ Have minimum scores of 4.5 in International English Language Testing System (IELTS) with writing minimum 4 or a TOEFL equivalent or an equivalent international certification
