RoSPA Level 2 Award in Defensive Driving (International)

Who is RoSPA Defensive Driving for?

This Award is suitable for anyone who is required to regularly drive as part of their work and can be delivered in the UK and Internationally. This qualification would also be suitable to meet driver training standards required by the oil and gas industry.

What will they get out of it?

The purpose of this Award is to develop the candidate's knowledge of the causes of work related driving incidents and provide them with the skills and knowledge needed to reduce the likelihood of them being involved in a road traffic incident. This course provides candidates with knowledge of factors that can influence a person's ability to drive safely. It also provides approaches to mitigate these risk factors, as well as enabling the candidate to develop a positive attitude towards driving.

What RoSPA Defensive Driving covers?

With RoSPA Defensive Driving course candidate will be able to:

- ① Recognise the risks associated with different driving environments.
- ② Recognise the factors that can lead to poor driving decision making and approaches to overcome them.
- ③ Understand the reasons why a pre journey vehicle check is required.
- ④ Conduct a pre journey vehicle check.
- ⑤ Demonstrate safe driving at work .

Entry Requirements

Entry to this Award is limited to those holding a full valid driver's license that covers them to drive in the jurisdiction where the training for the award is being delivered. RoSPA Qualifications will not restrict access on the grounds of prior academic attainment, age, employment or geographic location on any grounds.
